Qualifications, Experience and Skills

- The successful applicant will be expected to be involved in all activities to be undertaken by the NZ Major Sox from appointment.
- Experience with electronic scoring is also desirable and the person needs to be competent with the use of Stat Track, Turbo Stats, Game Changer or similar software.
- They must be prepared and able to collate information on NZ team players in various domestic competitions as required by Head Coach where practical be prepared to score opposition game for scouting purposes during tournaments.
- The person must be able to work within a team environment at various hours as requested by Management
- This position also includes assistance to Team Manager of various domestic duties whilst in camps or tournaments including the Canadian tournaments.
- The applicant needs to be qualified at Level 6 or 7 in the NZ Scoring Certification programme.
- The successful applicant should be aware that there may be a significant amount of self-funding required.
