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Touring Guide

1. Background and Purpose

The Softball New Zealand (SNZ) Umpiring Programme touring guide provides information for travelling members who represent the programme offshore.

The objective of this policy is to ensure travelling members are well-informed about their offshore engagement and all necessary arrangements are in place.

2. Scope

This policy covers all SNZ umpiring members who are currently financial and have permission from their UIC, RDU & SNZ Chief Umpire to represent the programme overseas.

3. Policy Statement

The touring guide process is an integral part of representing the national umpiring programme abroad. Being an ambassador of the programme and umpiring to the best of one's abilities is paramount.

4. Responsibility

The selected umpire must ensure they are fit and well prepared for their offshore assignment. The umpire must also follow the SNZ Umpire's Code of Conduct while abroad and abide by the rules and regulations of the overseas event. The selected umpire must represent the programme with the utmost respect.





The NUS are responsible for managing the selection or confirmation process for offshore assignments.
